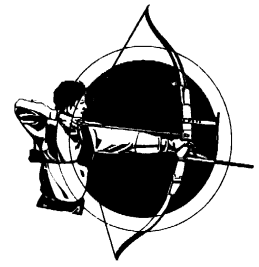
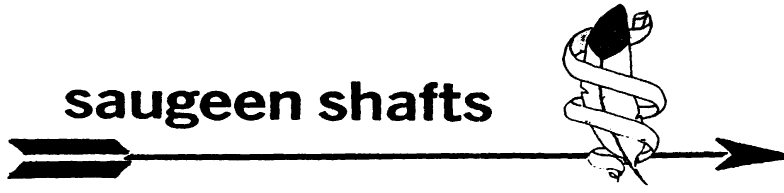

Tim's Tackle Tips

Well, June 1st is a very sad day for me. It means that turkey season is over. Unfortunately, I still had a tag in my pocket at the end of legal shooting time on Monday. On the up-side, I can now focus all my attention on the upcoming 3-D events. If you are one of those people that have a separate set of arrows for 3-D, you may need to come in and see me about re-tuning your bow. Even if your 3-D arrows are the same spine as your hunting arrows, they are probably a different diameter. They will not fly the same as your hunting arrows. You need to re-tune the 3-D arrows to get the best flight out of them.

There are lots of local shots all over Ontario. If you feel adventurous this summer, try to attend the major championships. These include the Ontario 3-d Championships, and the Ontario Triple Crown. All of these are top notch events, and the number of new people you can meet is staggering. Hope to see you at those events. I'll be there.
